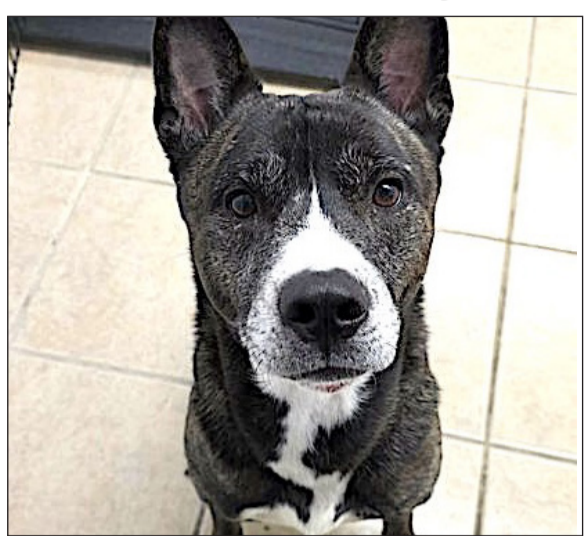
## Catty Corner

## Bedford County Humane Society



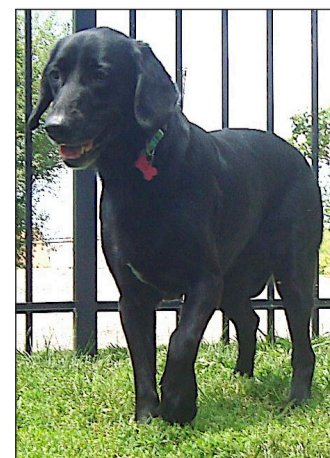
Pickles is a 2-month-old female domestic short-hair.
