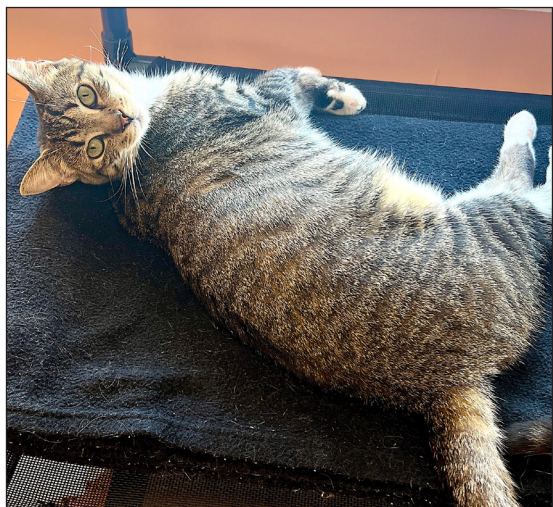

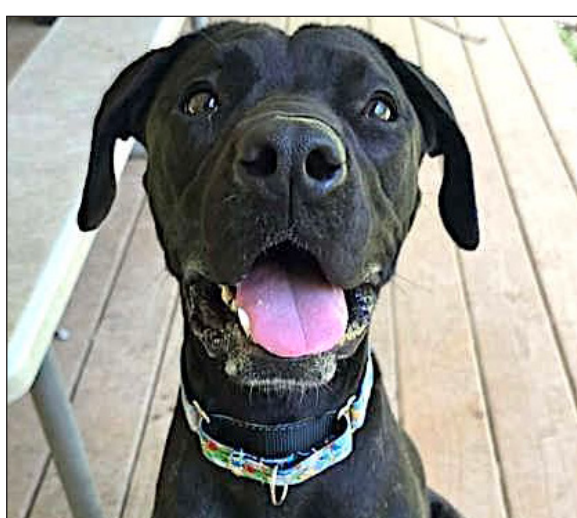
Catty Corner
