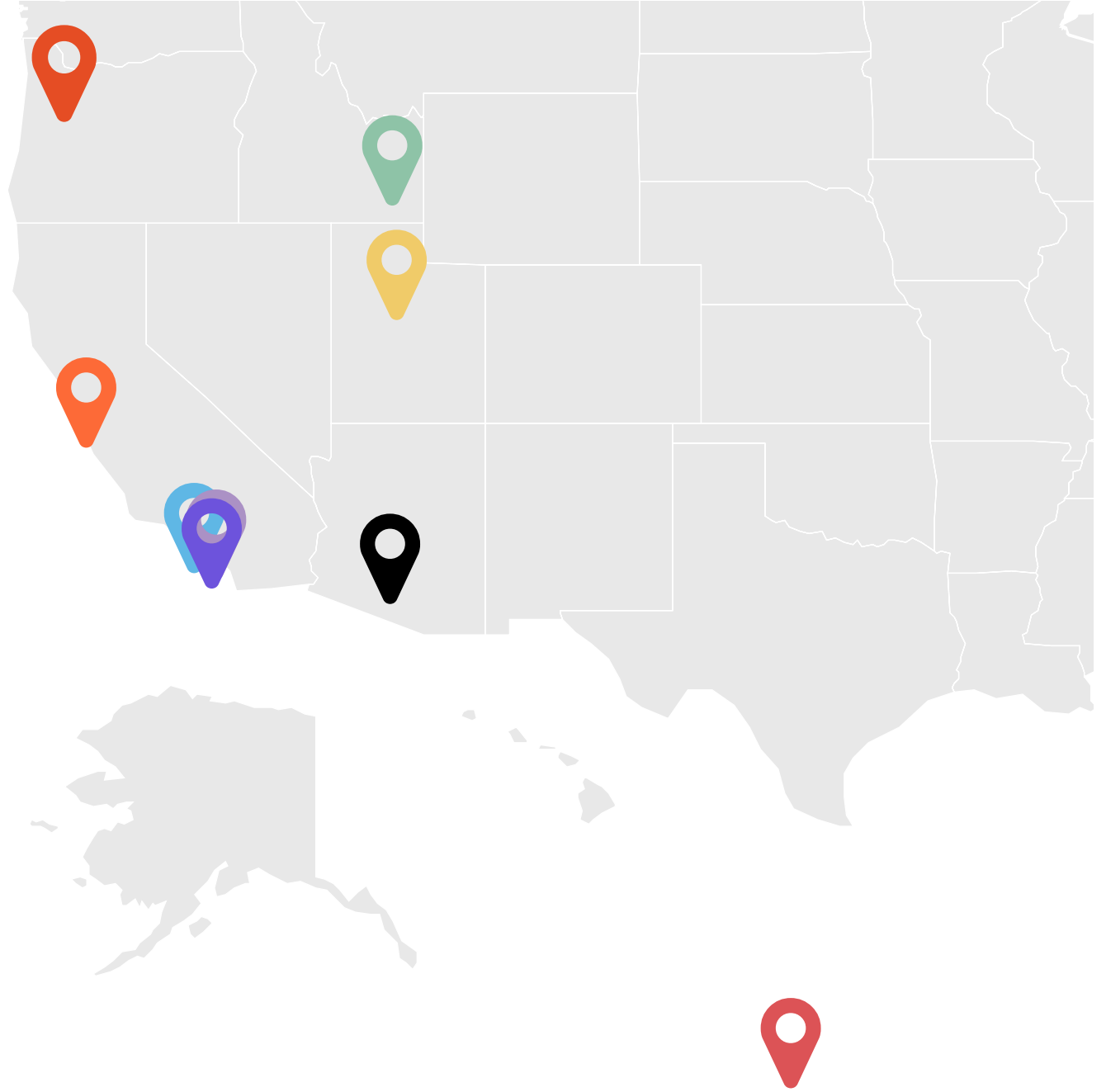


Between the years of 1957 to 1960 nine junior college campuses were purchased for \$8.3 million.
