

Public Notice to the Citizens of Brookline, NH

New Hampshire law requires that the Supervisors of the Checklist verify the checklist every ten years (RSA 654:39). Any person on the checklist who has not voted in the past four years must re-register to remain on the checklist. The Supervisors are sending notice letters to these voters at the address the voter provided when registering. The Supervisors of the Checklist for the Town of Brookline, NH will hold a session for re-registering voters who have not voted since April 1, 2017, accepting applications for new voter registration, accepting requests for the correction of the checklist, and or change of political party affiliation on:

Saturday May 15, 2021 from 11:30 AM – 12:30 PM
and Saturday June 26, 2021 from 11:30 AM – 12:30 PM
