Board of Registrar Session

July 13, 2021

New Hampshire law requires that the Board of Registrars verify the checklist every ten years. Any person on the checklist who has not voted in the past four years (since April 1, 2017) must re-register to remain on the checklist.

The Board of Registrars held a session on May 26, 2021, to determine which voters would be sent a notice letter to the address provided when registering.

The Board of Registrars for the City of Nashua will also hold a session for re-registering voters who have not voted since April 1, 2017, accepting applications for new voter registration, accepting requests for the correction of the checklist or change of political party affiliation on:

Applicants for registration who possess proof of identify, age, citizenship, and domicile should bring that proof when they come to register. Qualified applicants who do not possess proof or who do not bring proof with them may still register if they sign an affidavit attesting to their qualifications for identity, age, and citizenship, and / or domicile.

You may also register to vote by appearing in person at the City Clerk's Office during regular office hours. If you are not sure of your voter registration status, please contact the Clerk's Office at 589-3010, option 5.
