Notice of Filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission

The City of Nashua (City) hereby provides notice of its filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) of its Application for Licensing for the Mine Falls Project (FERC No. 3442) (Project). The FERC filing was made on July 30, 2021. The Application provides details of the 3.0- megawatt (MW) Project located on the Nashua River in New Hampshire. The infrastructure associated with the Project including dam, power canal, intake, powerhouse, and tailrace is in Nashua, New Hampshire. The Project impoundment extends approximately 4.3 miles (mi) upstream to Runnells Bridge Road in Hollis, New Hampshire. The Project is an existing constructed Project. No new construction is planned.

The Project is located in the City of Nashua in Hillsborough County, New Hampshire on the Nashua River.
