QUESTION RELATING TO SPORTS BOOK RETAIL OPERATIONS

RSA 287 I:6 requires that if the operation of sports retail book operations is to be allowed in a city or town that the question be put to voters of said city or town. QUESTION RELATING TO CHARTER AMENDMENT

In accordance with RSA 49-B:6, the question and a summary of the text for a proposed charter amendment appear below. This question will appear on the ballot for the November 2, 2021, Municipal Election. Complete text of the proposed amendment is also available in the City Clerk’s Office and in the Voter Information Guide posted on the City Clerk’s Elections page on the City website (www.nashuanh.gov). If approved by the voters at the November 2, 2021 regular municipal election, this charter amendment will be effective January 1, 2022.

2. Shall the City approve the proposed Charter Amendment summarized below relative to the increase in membership and appointment to the Nashua Police Commissioners by the Mayor and the President of the Board of Aldermen upon approval of the Board of Aldermen?

The amendment changes the membership of Nashua Board of Police Commissioners from three commissioners appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, to five commissioners with three appointed by the Mayor and two appointed by the President of the Board of Aldermen and all confirmed by the Board of Aldermen. Appointments shall be based upon qualifications, merit and record of community service and should be balanced so that the membership of the Commission reflects the citizenship of the City. Members of the immediate family of and residents of the same household with the Mayor and any Alderman would be ineligible.
