



LEGAL NOTICE

CITY OF NASHUA

To the Voters of the City of Nashua

The Registrar of Voters will be in session Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for additions and corrections to the checklist. Wednesday, August 31, 2022, is the last day that the City Clerk may accept voter registration applications or make name or address corrections to the checklist prior to the State Primary Election on September 13, 2022. New voters may also register at the polls on Election Day. (RSA 654:27, 654:28, 654:7-a, 654:32).

The Board of Registrars will meet on Thursday, September 1, 2022, at 10:30 a.m. in Conference Room 208, City Hall, 229 Main Street, Nashua, to certify the checklist to be used for the September 13, 2022 State Primary Election, and to conduct such other business as may come before it.

May 31, 2022 was the last day a registered voter could change party affiliation prior to the September 13, 2022 State Primary Election. The polls will be open from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. If you are not sure on your party affiliation, you may visit the City Clerk's Office to view the posted checklist or visit the State of New Hampshire Voter Information Look-up website at <http://app.sos.nh.gov>.

If you are listed on the checklist as affiliated with either the Republican or Democratic party you may vote only on that party's ballot at the State Primary Election. If you are registered as Undeclared, you may declare a party affiliation on primary day. If you have voted at a previous State or Presidential Primary, and you have not subsequently changed your party affiliation, you are registered as affiliated with the party whose ballot you voted at that primary.
