

Announcement to Former Serenity Place Patients:

In 2018, all patient records in the custody of Serenity Place were transferred to the State of New Hampshire, DHHS, BDAS. The Serenity Place records transferred to BDAS are being held at BDAS 's office located at 105 Pleasant Street, Concord, NH 03301. If you are a former patient and you want to obtain a copy of your own records, you can do so by completing a Request for Access to Client's Own Confidential Information. If you are a person requesting a former patient's records with the patient's permission, you can do so by completing an Authorization Form. Once BDAS receives an executed Request or Authorization, a representative will contact you to schedule an appointment for you to pick up the records. **Please be advised that BDAS anticipates destroying Serenity Place patient files and records in its custody on October 1, 2022. You should, therefore, take prompt action to request a copy of your records.**
