The Milford School Board will hold a Public Hearing at **7:00 PM, Monday, May 18, 2026**, in the Milford High School Lecture Hall. This Public Hearing is being held in accordance with RSA 198:20-b to accept an equipment donation.

NH Law requires that the Supervisors of the Checklist verify the checklist every year. The first meeting will be on Tuesday, June 2 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Hall Lobby. Applicants for registrations must possess proof of identity, age, citizenship and domicile and should bring that proof when they come to register.
